100 Club rules

Purpose

The purpose of the 100 Club is to raise funds. The money will be paid into the PTA bank account and used to meet funding requests from the school, providing equipment, resources and opportunities for pupils.

Rules

- 1. For a cost of £5.00 per month (i.e. per draw) you will be allocated one number between 1 and 100.
- 2. A draw will be made every month, with a 1st prize
- 3. The prizes will total 25% of the annual income.
- 4. The 100 Club is a private lottery and is open to all parents, carers, staff and friends of Dunswell Academy School. Anyone aged 16 or over can join.
- 5. Numbers are limited to two per household
- 6. Payments must be made by standing order or annual one-off bank transfer.
- 7. Members' numbers will only be entered if their subscription is up to date.
- 8. If a member has no valid reason for missing a payment, their number may be sold to someone on the reserve list.
- 9. The draw shall be made by the headteacher/ a member of the PTA in school.
- 10. The winning amount will be transferred to your bank account within one week of the draw.
- 11. The name and numbers for each month's winners will be posted in the school newsletter
- 12. The 100 Club is run by Dunswell Academy's PTA. In case of any dispute the decision of the committee is final.
- 13. Unless otherwise advised, a member will be deemed to have left the 100 Club if his/her subscription renewal remains unpaid for a period of one month.
- 14. If a winner cannot be contacted, the winnings will be placed into PTA funds after six months.
