New accident reporting procedures

From Monday 25th September, we will be reporting any accidents during school time via text message. Any accidents which have been reported in the school's accident book will be reported to parents at 3.15pm. These will only go to the person who is named as contact one on our school system and it will be that person's responsibility to pass on the accident to another contact if needed. We will continue to call if there are any significant injuries otherwise, they will be reported on a text message. This will mean that children will no longer bring home a bump note.

The accident report will give brief details which will include child initials, class, how it occurred, the injury sustained, and treatment given, if any e.g.

ZN (C2) tripped over on the playground and bumped head, red mark on left side of forehead. Ice pack applied.

Punctuality

We are already seeing a number of children arriving at school late. School begins at 8.50am and the gate closes and register closes at 8.55am. Anyone arriving after this time, will have late minutes added to their register.

Harvest Festival

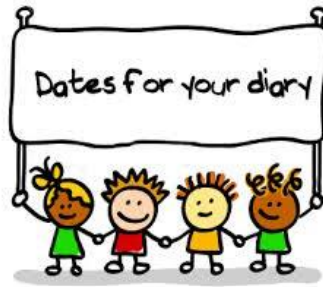
