We now have a number of people supporting reading across the school so thank you very much to those people for volunteering.

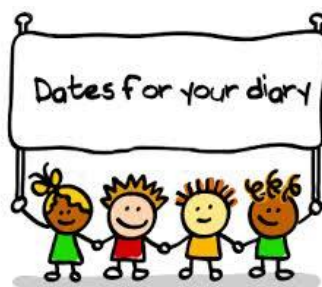


Reading Book
