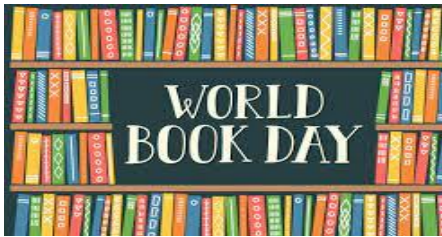

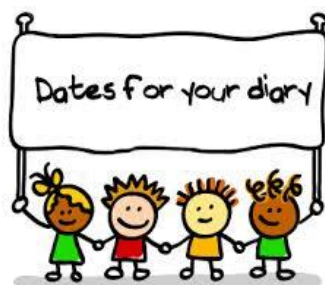
## Parent Readers

**Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> March** – school closes for Easter


**Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> April** – school opens for the Summer Term
