## Dear Parents and Carers,

To support our learning in Class 4 this term we will be visiting Gainsborough Old Hall. This will help to reinforce our history work about The Tudors. During the visit, children will be able to explore Tudor architecture as well as experience the difference between social classes in Tudor times. A led workshop will provide children with the opportunity to delve deeper into Tudor life and experience Henry VIII's court. Pupils will take part in hands-on activities, try on costumes, and learn more about the people who lived and worked at the hall.

The trip will take place on Friday 18<sup>th</sup> October. We will leave school at 9.00am and will arrive back at school at approximately 3.30pm. Children should wear their school uniform and take a packed lunch in a named carrier bag.

The cost of the trip is  $\pounds$ 20 per child. This includes transport to and from the venue, entrance to the Hall and a led workshop. Payments should be made through Parent Pay and this will also provide the consent needed for your child to take part.
