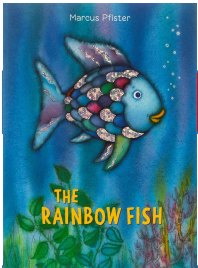

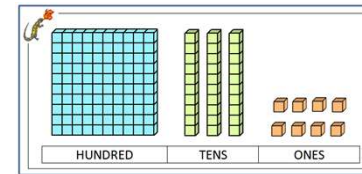


Phonics: Review of summer term sounds

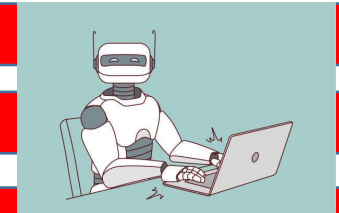
